Having grown up surrounded by quilts from both of her grandmothers, and inspired by the quilts of Amish communities in Pennsylvania, Nancy Allen has made more than 100 quilts of her own, and estimates she could make 50 more with the scraps in her sewing cabinet. Here she explains three different methods of scrap quilting which she dubs "coordinated scrappy," "planned scrappy," and "make-do scrappy" and presents nine quilt patterns, with variations for each method. Allen provides tips, tricks, and techniques like paper piecing, appliqué, half-square triangles, strip piecing, and chain piecing, in patchwork quilts that use fat eighths, fat quarters, and yardage as well as precut strips and squares. "Don't let the black-and-yellow cover fool you: Triple-Play Scrap Quilting is one colorful book. There are nine quilts featured, and each one is shown in three different colorways for a completely different look. This is a great resource for using up your stash or adding to it in an organized way so that you can achieve beautiful results." Quilter 80.
