The subjects appear to be the Avatas of Vishnu. We are unable to ascertain the meaning of the inscription on the back, which is modern Nagari in Sanskrit characters. The value of the dish will not be great, there being lew collectors of these things. J. O K., Ballymoney (4,101).--Judging from sketch and particulars sent, your cup and saucer in black ware are productions of the Wedgwood factory. The three letters, F.G.W., however, suggest a late period of manufacture, probably since 1851, and the value will therefore be quite nominal, from los. to 15s., according to finish. Prints.--G....
