




The New Junior College: The Next Step in Free Public Education (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)

Excerpt from The New Junior College: The Next Step in Free Public Education This bulletin deals with a relatively new but rapidly developing area or division of public education in these United States. There is, as yet, no commonly accepted name for this new educational unit or institution. George D. Stoddard, president of the University of Illinois, has suggested the term tertiary education, which serves to indicate its position with reference to (1) the two existing lower levels - primary and secondary; and (2) the higher, truly collegiate levels; i.e., the senior college and the university. Time alone will reveal whether this term becomes standard. While it is descriptive of the general area to be served, it does not describe well the nature of the new institution which is taking form. At present the relatively few institutions which are attempting to serve the educational needs in this area are most commonly known as junior colleges and technical institutes, but neither of these terms, because of its well-established usage, indicates adequately the nature of the objectives to be...
